Call to Order:

Scott Greener called the meeting to order. Allegiance was pledged to the flag and roll call was taken. .

General Discussion:

There were no personal appearances at the meeting. Scott Greener motioned to approve the minutes of the August 12, 2015 meeting. Jerry Ford seconded the motion. A unanimous vote approved the minutes.

- Old business: Scott Greener made a motion to appoint Alice Redding as the secretary for the board, seconded by Rick Schopfer, unanimous vote of approval.
- New Business: Jerry Ford commented that a ¼ cent sales tax for public safety would be helpful to assist the department with needed funds for future hires. Chief Gurin mentioned his concern for additional staff in the future with new business in the Peculiar Way (211th street) area. Paul Cannova made a motion for the board to support a ¼ cent public safety sales tax recommendation to the Board of Alderman. This motion was seconded by Jerry Ford, with a unanimous vote of approval.
