***IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 400.820, PAVING REQUIRED, ALTERNATIVES;
CITY OF PECULIAR MUNICIPAL CODE:***

C. All new driveways within the City's Right-of-Way shall be constructed and ready for use prior to the issuance of a certificate of occupancy and shall be paved in accordance with specifications approved by the City Engineer as follows:

1. A six (6)-inch layer of reinforced Portland cement concrete shall be placed on a 6-inch MoDOT Type 5 base (clean gravel), and on compacted sub-grade - without exception.

Concrete shall meet Kansas City Metropolitan Chapter of the American Public Works Association (APWA), DIVISION II, CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS STREETS, SECTION 2200 PAVING.

Mix Design shall meet Kansas City Metropolitan Materials Board (KCMMB) 4K psi w/granite aggregate specifications or better.

Reinforcement shall be No. 4 Rebar, 12-inches on-center each way.

NOTE: Any damage to City of Peculiar facilities or utilities within the area of work caused by the contractor will be deemed by the City of Peculiar as either "non-emergency" or "emergency" upon notification of the damages.

Repair to damages will be performed as follows: Non-emergency: the contractor will have four (4) hours to propose a repair plan to the city for a complete repair within three (3) business days. Emergency: upon notification of the damage, the contractor must immediately submit a repair plan that will take no more than four (4) hours to respond on-site and complete repairs within 24 hours of notification of damage. In either case, if the proposed plan is unacceptable for any reason to the City of Peculiar, repairs will be made by the city with all costs billed to the contractor.

It shall be unlawful for any person, except employees of the City in the course of their employment, to open, dig into, remove the surface from, excavate, bore or tunnel under any street, sidewalk, alley, public Right-of-Way or public place without first obtaining a permit. Any work begun without a permit shall be stopped immediately upon notice from the Codes Enforcement Officer. The Codes Enforcement Officer shall be notified of Emergency Excavations the morning of the next regular business day.
